DEFINITIONS:

Concurrent dual degree – matriculation into two degree programs at different academic levels (e.g. Bachelor and Associate). Separate dual degree – graduation from one-degree program and then matriculation into a second degree program at the same (Associate and Associate or Bachelor and Bachelor) or different levels where there is at least a full-year of study beyond the first degree to earn the second (a minimum of 30 unique credits). Double major – (1.) the concurrent matriculation into two degree programs at the same academic level (e.g. Associate and Associate or Bachelor and Bachelor) or (2.) the graduation from one-degree program and then matriculation into a second degree program at the same or different level where there is less than a full-year of study beyond the first degree to earn the second (a minimum of 30 unique credits).

EXCLUSIONS:

All students enrolled in the Associate in Science in Medical Assisting are dually enrolled into the Certificate in Medical Assisting.
